

The Village of Nehawka Board of Trustees set up a special meeting, an open and public meeting, on Tuesday, July 21, 2026, at 5:00 p.m., at the Nehawka Community Building with Scott Hrabik of JEO Consulting Group. Notice of meeting was posted on July 16, 2026, in three (3) locations – Village office window (217 Sherman Ave), Nehawka Post Office (418 Elm St), and First State Bank (412 Elm St). Chairman Chad Krueger; Trustee, Pat Neu; and Scott Hrabik of JEO were in attendance. Trustees, Tim Dineen, Ian Begemann, and Matt Anson were absent. Meeting opened at 4:55 p.m., noted the location of the Open Meetings Act for public viewing. Ryan Adams and John Henderson arrived at 5:20 p.m. and 5:30 p.m. respectively.

Reviewed and discussed updates to the 1 & 6-Year Street Plan and applying for a MAPA Grant, noted the grant minimum amount is \$250,000 and the village is considering a \$500,000 grant for street, water and sewer work. Continued review of Elm St and Sherman Avenue intersection project on site – reviewed layout of the paving, adding new drainage, and discussed adding handicap parking on the Elm Street side of the Community Building. Meeting resumed in Community Building and discussed adding new water and or sewer lines and four water shutoffs prior to paving of intersection. Other street projects discussed were adding an overlay to Oak Street, paving 230 feet of Railroad Ave with new sewer main, and grinding/overlay of Washington Avenue between Main Street and Sherman Avenue. Scott Hrabik will update Nehawka's 1 & 6-Year Street Plan for board review.
