

The Village of Nehawka Board of Trustees met in special session on Tuesday, June 21, 2022 at the Nehawka Community Building. Chairman June Bennett called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m., noted the Open Meetings Act displayed for public viewing, roll call of the board. In attendance: June Bennett, Bob Sorenson, John Henderson, Jason Jackson, Tim Dineen. Other attendees: Christine Lowther.

Appoint Clerk/Treasurer: Bennett and Dineen presented information on each applicant and noted qualifications and strengths of each applicant. Noted that two of the three applicants were interviewed prior to meeting. Motion by Henderson, seconded by Dineen to appoint Christine Lowther to the Clerk/Treasurer position. Jackson abstained. Motion carried.

July 8-9 Street Dance – Nomads Bar Special Designated License for Beer Garden: discussion on the open meetings requirement to have separate agenda item for special designated license – provided information on conversations with bar owner and that the event was in the process of being cancelled. No action taken by board due to event cancellation.

Jackson/Lindsey Sewer Issue Westside of Nehawka: provided information on problem area and need to abandon old line and replace sewer line in Oak Street alley and West Street. Will get three or four quotes for replacement and will need to determine elevation, fall percentage, and number of manholes will be needed.

The board thanked Neu for the work she accomplished with the board and village.
